

Come share your art and celebrate the birds of a feather—





If you are available on Election Day You can become an Officer of Election And really get into the process

Get Involved ... Become an Officer of Election

The Loudoun County Electoral Board employs more than 1,000 poll workers, or Officers of Election, to conduct each election. Loudoun enjoys a reputation for conducting well run elections, and we need your help to maintain this tradition.

Any registered voter in Virginia who enjoys working with people is eligible. All that is required is a day of your time one or two times a year, plus attendance at a training session that takes place in the weeks prior to the election. The day begins at 5 a.m. as the polls are prepared for voters and ends after the votes are counted, usually around 8:30 p.m. We prefer workers who are willing to stay the entire day, but half-day shifts are also available.

Election Officers are paid \$125 for each election (\$55 for a half day) plus \$20 for each training session.
