iLearn**C**hinese for Ecomystery


In Art, all classes in grades 1 through 8 have been learning about Chinese Calligraphy. We will be using this writing system on


March 11th as part of this year's EcoMystery during the Chinese Culture Study. An excellent writing and dictionary App called iLearnChinese is available on iPad and iPhone for \$4.99. It demonstrates correct character formation, and then allows the student to practice drawing the character on the screen. The App also pronounces words and phrases. You may want to try the free version, iLearnChineseLite, which does not contain the dictionary. It offers fine motor and sequential memory challenges, and is a fun way to learn some Chinese.

We will be using iLearnChinese during the EcoMystery to help us form characters correctly. We would love to have multiple copies to use. If you own an iPad or iPhone and would be willing to let your child bring it to school that morning to use during the EcoMystery, please contact Amy Krumich, akrumich@thehillschool.org.
