

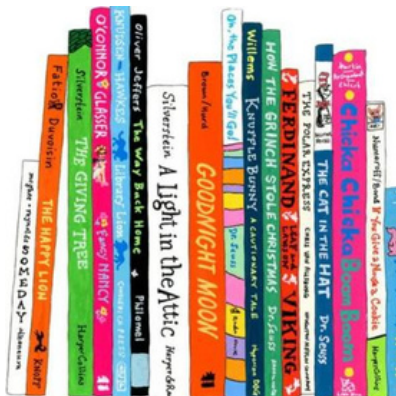
The Book Fair will accept payments in cash, check, school charge to BigSIS (see below), or credit card (if a parent is present).

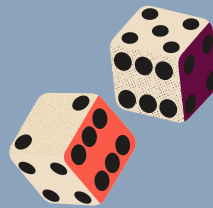

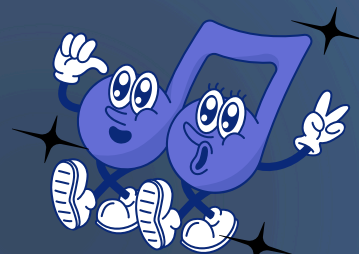

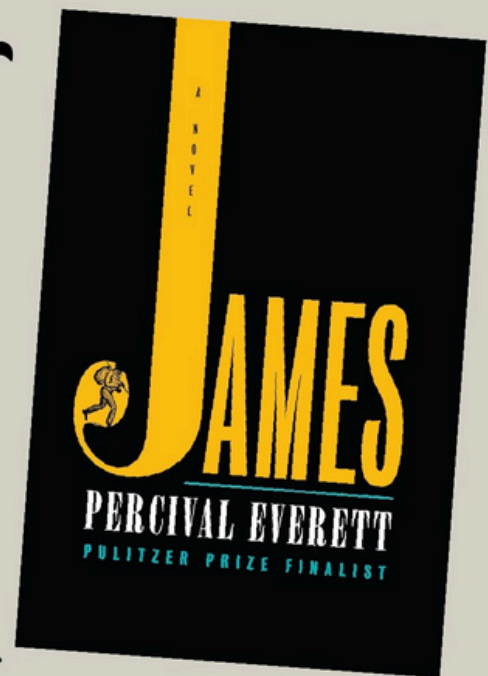
Tal was a devoted and longtime middle school homeroom and English teacher serving on the faculty from 1980-2013. At Hill

Faces And Our Cultures provides Guatemalan students with a unique opportunity to immerse themselves in our community for eight enriching weeks. Throughout the years, our campus has welcomed some Guatemalan students, many of whom have created a special bond with their host families.
