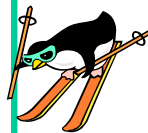

Ski season is coming!

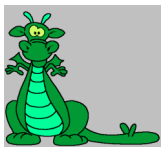
Sign up forms are due **TOMORROW!**

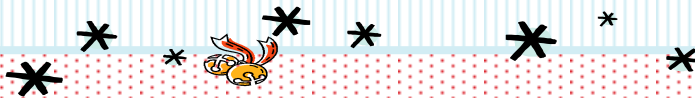
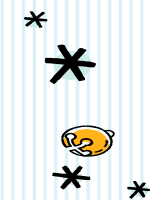
