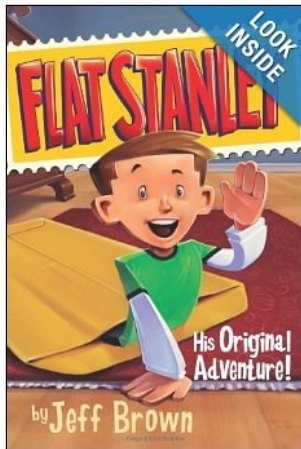




SECOND GRADE NEWS
