Every morning this month, as part of our math workshop, the children are measuring.

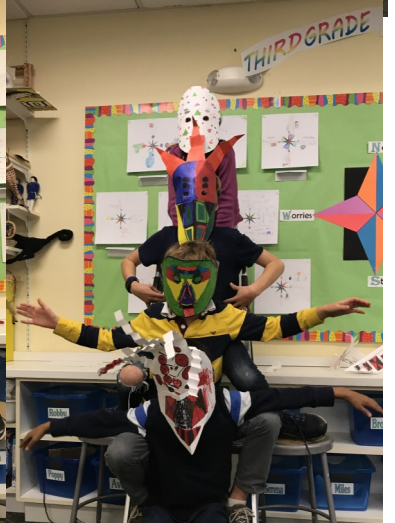
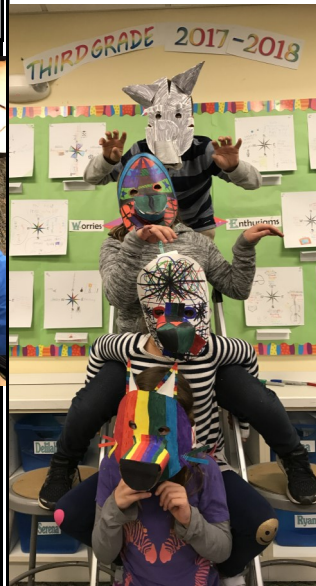
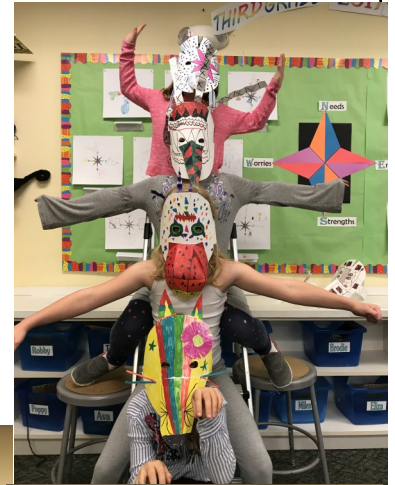
