

In 1926, Hill School was founded by Mrs. Thomas A. Atkinson, Mrs. C. Oliver Iselin, Jr., and Mrs. William P. Hulbert.

In 1928 the school was incorporated and for a number of years its Board of Trustees was headed by its founding mothers. Its later Board of Directors was made up of “women with children in the school” and in 1933 Mrs. William (Billy) Mitchell became President of the Board.
