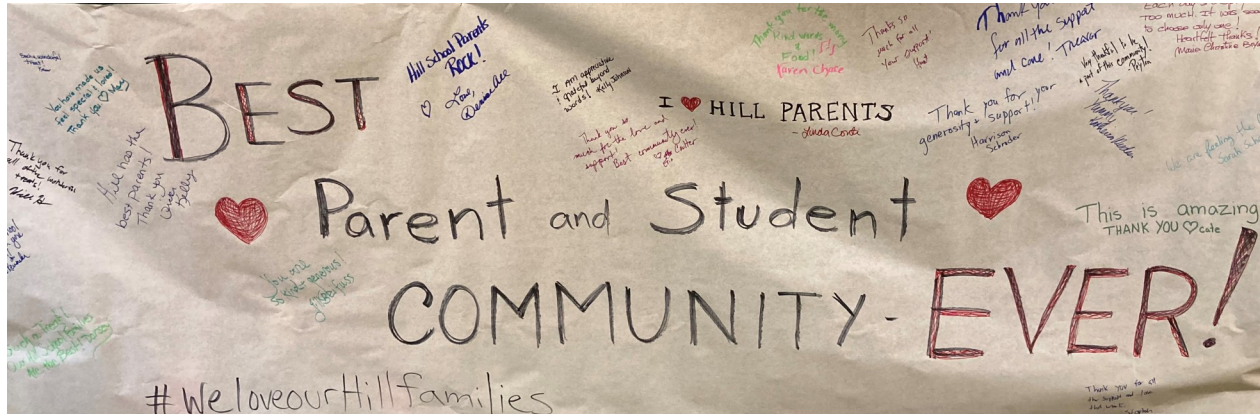

Donations support JUST TRYAN IT. Our grants give families with a child in treatment for cancer stabilized housing, reliable transportation and pay for essentials like food and utilities.

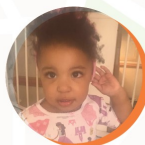
