1. Login to your BigSIS portal, <https://thehillsschool.bigsis.com/portal>
2. Go to **Parents Tab** at the top, then the **Forms Tab**, there you will find a form for each child/lunch.
3. You will need to fill out a form **for each child and lunch** (still easier than paper forms!!)
4. When you select a Form you will need to **Claim the form** by clicking the green Claim icon.
5. Make your selection, agree to fee (the cost of lunch), click **Save and move to final step**.
6. Select payment option, check the verify box and click the **Complete and Pay** icon.
7. Click **Exit Form** icon to go back to the forms page to fill out another form.
