In conjunction with Picture Day on Tuesday September 17th, we will be offering an optional vision screening for all students in Kindergarten through fifth grade. The screenings will be completed by Dr. Shae Christensen from Associates in Eyecare in Stone Ridge. If your child wears glasses, please ensure they bring them to school that day.

Please note that this is a screening and should not be considered a substitute for a complete professional eye examination. The screening will just identify children who would benefit from additional evaluation.
