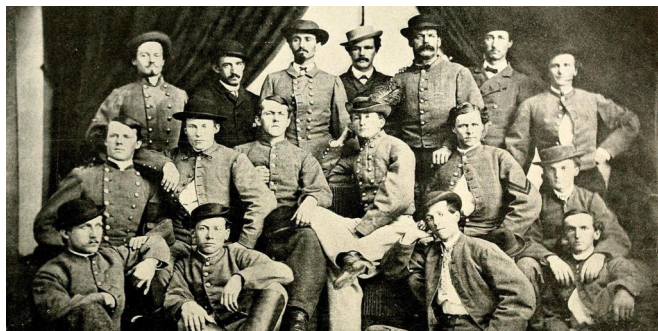


**On Saturday, November 9th, 2019** the Middleburg American Legion Post 295 and Boy Scout Troop 2950 are holding the

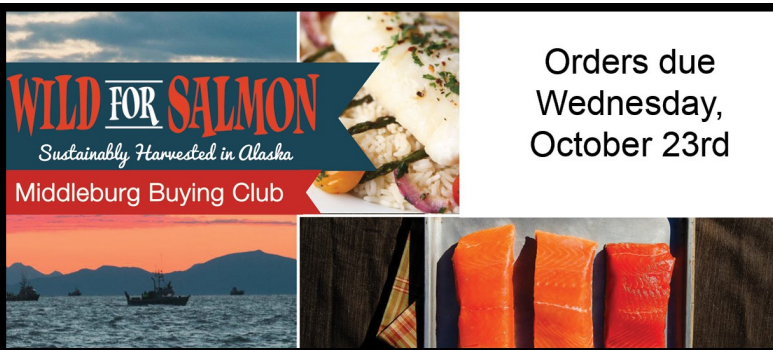

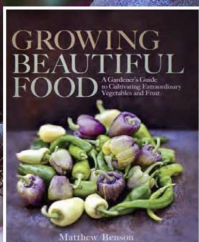
