In Writing Workshop this week, we learned about punctuation (. ! ?). Ask your child what each symbol's name is and how it is used to end a sentence. In Reading Workshop, we continued to work within our small groups on phonics, reading short sentences, and learning sight words and word families.

In Math Workshop, we have been counting the letters in our names and comparing them with others' names, as well as graphing our class results. Yesterday, each child made a snowman as tall as the letters in their names. They also worked on sorting the names of their classmates from longest to shortest and vice versa.

Our mentors joined us on Tuesday and helped us make origami ducks. Then we played on the playground. The Kindergarteners wish every day was a mentor day!

In handwriting, we are working on lower case vowels. So, if you see your children writing their names, encourage them to use lower case letters :)
