DIRECTIONS TO BRYCE RESORT

TRAVEL TIME: Approximately 1 hour 30 minutes

- a. Middleburg to Interstate 81 S.
- b. From Interstate 81 S. take Exit 273 (Mt. Jackson, Basye).
- c. Make a right at stop sign at the end of the exit ramp. (Rt. 703 W)
 d. Continue until next stop sign take a
- left. (Rt. 614)
- e. Stay on this road until you come to a stop sign - make a right. (Rt. 263 W)
- f. Follow this road until you turn right into Bryce Resort.

Please do not rely on GPS, it will take you over secondary and service roads. Thesé directions are more efficient.
