

Ride Your Pony To School

Directions:

The meet will be at Dr. and Mrs. Andrew Bishop's "Stonehedge" Farm at 2426 Stonehedge Road. The meet is NOT all the way down the driveway to the house- it is in the field at the top of the hill on your right. You should see the horse trailers and a sign!

From Middleburg, go south on The Plains Road, past the back Hill School driveway, past the Dornin Science Center and past the M.A.R.E. center. After you pass Sullivan's Lane, you'll see Hulbert's lane on your left as you go down the hill. Go left on Hulbert's Lane. Pass Springfield Farm lane on your right. And then turn right into Stonehedge Farm Lane. Pass the red barn on the right and you'll see the parking area in the field.

Riding:

Plan to arrive by 7:00am <u>and check in</u>. We will leave promptly at 7:20am with no wiggle room! The ride itself should take about a half hour. We will leave Stonehedge farm, cross over Hulbert's, go up through the M.A.R.E. Center and arrive in the back parking lot, by the outdoor amphitheater of the Hill School.

Parents do not normally ride with their children, but are welcome to walk alongside their children and many often do. Younger or less experienced riders should be accompanied by a parent and on a lead line if necessary.

There will be juices and donuts etc. provided by the school at the end of the ride.

No riders will be permitted to ride without a proper helmet and signed waiver. No exceptions.

Important Information:

The ride will end in the parking lot by the outdoor amphitheater. <u>Parents, trainers, or grooms</u> <u>must ride or walk the ponies back to Stonehedge as there is not ample space to bring in and</u> <u>tum around trailers at the school or barn</u>. We would like to continue to be able to offer this event and to do so, all must follow the rules, including parents, trainers and grooms. All riders, including parents, must always wear appropriate helmets when mounted.
