

Culture Study - Tanzania Chipsi Mayai

Serves 2 - this recipe can be doubled

Chipsi Mayai is Swahili for chips and eggs, also known as zege, and is the most popular street food found all over Tanzania. This dish was invented in the streets of Dar es Salaam. In its most basic form, Chipsi Mayai is a simple potato-egg omelet. Every vendor has their own recipe.

8 ounces frozen french fries 2 tablespoons avocado oil or ghee (clarified butter) 1/2 cup chopped onion 1 tomato seeds removed and chopped 1/2 red bell pepper, chopped 4 eggs beaten 1 teaspoon kosher salt (diamond crystal)

For serving: Chopped cilantro or parsley Hot sauce and/or ketchup Chapati bread

- Preheat the oven according to the french fry package
- Bake the french fries
- Chop the onions, tomatoes and red bell pepper
- Heat a large saute pan to medium high heat and add the oil and or clarified butter
- Add the onions, tomatoes and red bell peppers and stir until they are softened and lightly browned
- Distribute the vegetables evenly in the pan with the french fries and pour the beaten eggs on top
- Let the eggs cook undisturbed for about 2-3 minutes
- When you see the edges looking firm flip the eggs over to finish cooking
- Slide the Chipsi Mayai out onto a plate and cut into wedges
- Serve with ketchup, hot sauce, parsley or cilantro and Chapati bread


