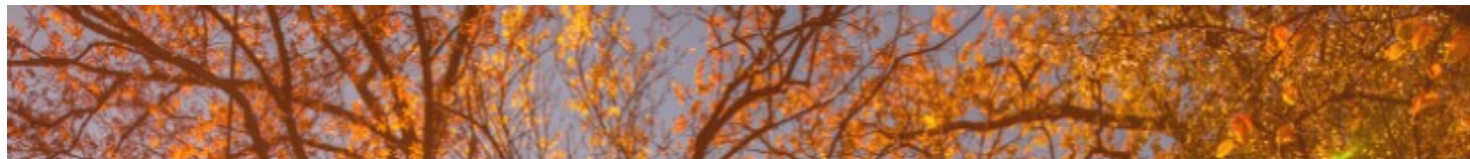

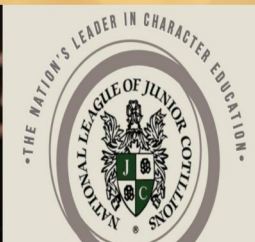
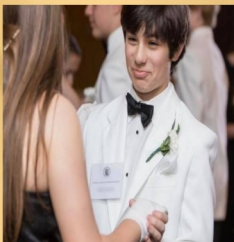

Year-Round Swim Lessons

LESSONS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AT SALAMANDER MIDDLEBURG

Salamander Middleburg has partnered with swim coach Ann Baird to teach children swimming skills as well as being “water safe.” Children will develop confidence in the water while learning different strokes such as Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Butterfly. Ann has been coaching for 13 years and is a United States Swim Assoc. (USSSA) Certified Coach. Ann is certified in CPR, First Aid, Lifeguarding, and Aquatics Fitness.

TODDLER CLASSES

Toddler classes are for ages three to five years old. With lots of games, toys and singing, your child will learn at their own pace and will be placed in a class based on their ability. As they complete each level, they will be rewarded with a fun prize and move up to the next level. Class sizes are small and consist of two to three toddlers. This curriculum is progression-based, meaning each level is broken down into simple achievable skills, while having a fun and positive experience.

KIDS CLASSES

Kids’ classes are for ages six years and up. Your child will learn at their own pace and be placed in a class based on their ability. As they complete each level, they will be rewarded with a fun prize and move up to the next level. Class sizes are small and consist of four to five children. This curriculum is progression-based, meaning each level is broken into simple achievable skills, while having a fun and positive experience.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons are available for ages three years and up. These lessons allow the individual to work directly with Coach Ann on a personalized level and help focus on particular skills. This is also a great opportunity for adults who wish to learn to swim, or for some aquatic exercise. It is never too late to learn!
