## TRAFFIC CIRCLE INFORMATION



- JK through Grade 3 students are dismissed from the Main Entrance traffic circle.
- Students in Grades 4 through 8 are dismissed from the traffic circle behind the Art Building, unless they are riding in a carpool with a younger child; these grade 4-8 students will be picked up at the Main Entrance traffic circle.
- Reminder: A portion of the entrance road will be closed during the school day. As a result, the traffic circle by the gym and art building will be accessible from The Plains Road entrance ONLY, and the Main Entrance traffic circle will be accessible from South Madison Street ONLY.
- Please display your name tag prominently in your windshield for dismissal, especially in the first few weeks. If you need more name tags, please see Silvia Fleming.




# Astra's Summer Reading Challenge
