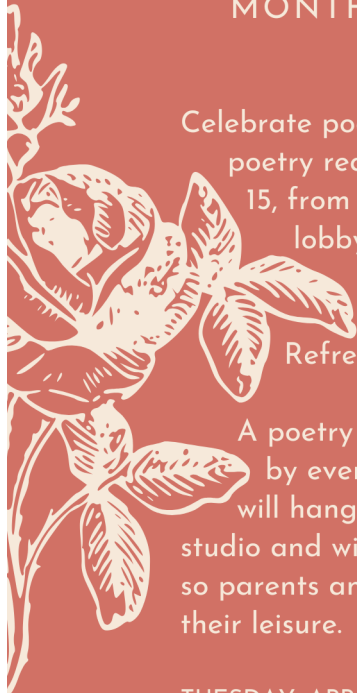
## CELEBRATE NATIONAL POETRY MONTH AT HILL!
