4. One cake will be awarded Best in Show.

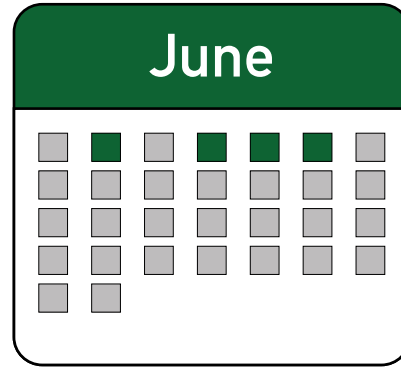
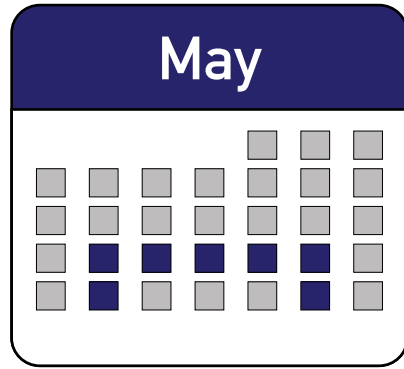

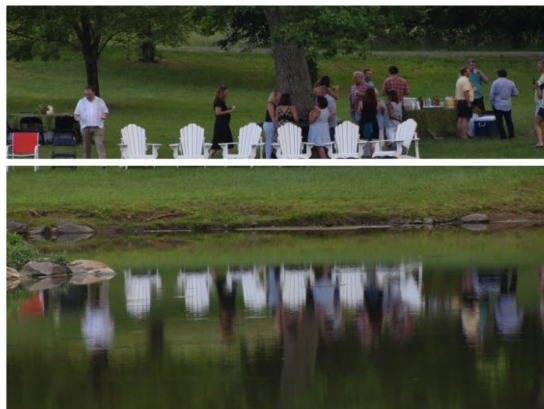
