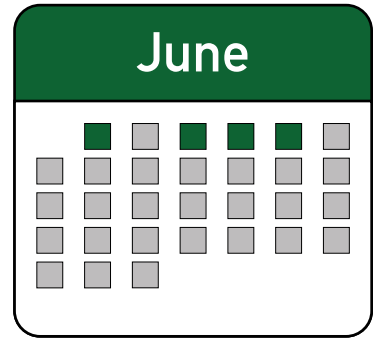
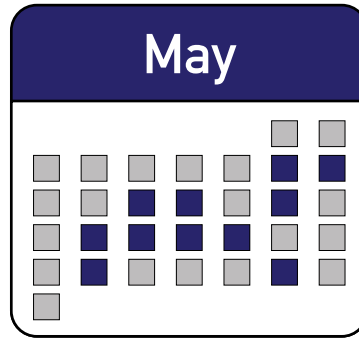
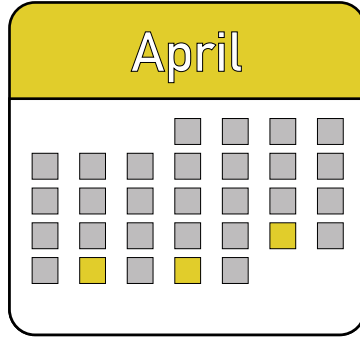

Programs at Hill

Music

Our music curriculum follows a spiral design from Junior Kindergarten through Grade 8, fostering a love of music, strong singing skills, rhythmic competency, and confident performance. The goal is to build individual confidence while helping students develop their strengths through making music.

Students sing and play drums, xylophones (JK-Grade 6), strings (Grades 3-4), and ukulele (Grades 7-8), building skills in healthy vocal production, rhythmic recall, ear training, and instrumental proficiency.

This performance-based program includes the Thanksgiving Assembly, Holiday Concerts, Spring Sing, the Eighth Grade Musical, and the Coffee House Concert (Grades 6-8).

Music also supports the theatre program, strengthening singing, acting, movement, and musical storytelling.

- All attendees will receive a tree seedling.

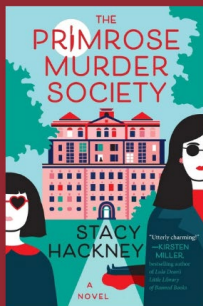
